A good time was had by all on Danger Island every evening from Aug. 2 until Aug. 6th from 5:30 until 7:30 pm. The kids survived:

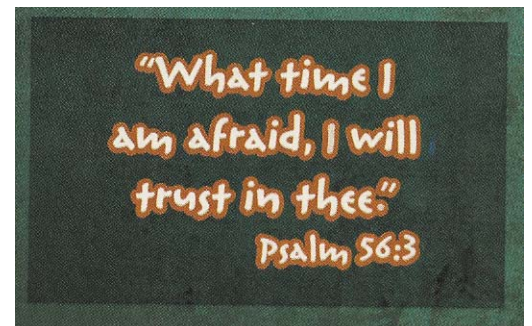
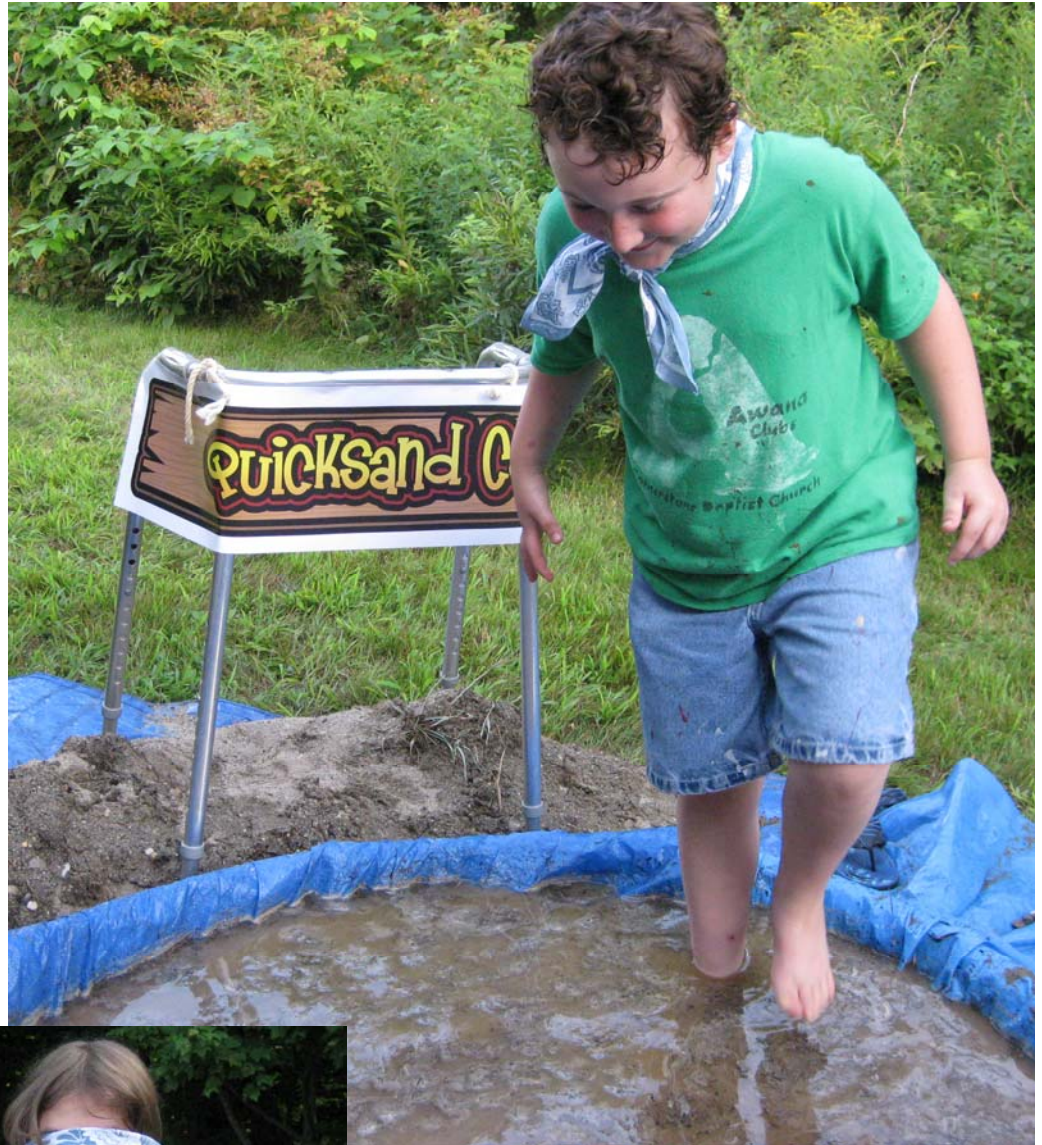
Quicksand Cove, Shipwreck Point, Big Shadow Cave, Boggy Swamp, and Hot Rock Volcano.
