## Fill a baby bottle and support a local pregnancy care center

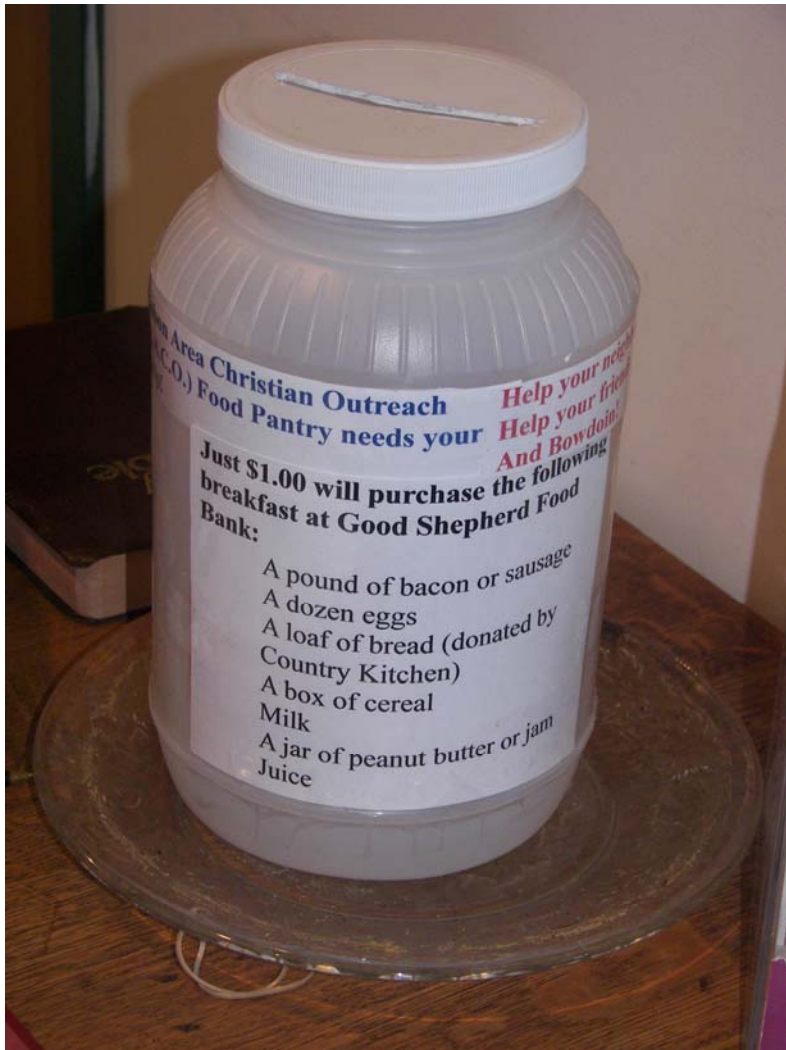
