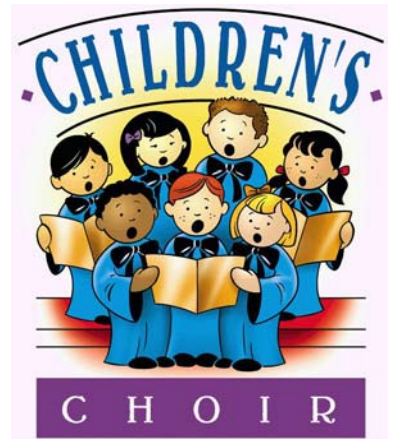
St. Matt's unveils its new sign on Route 196
